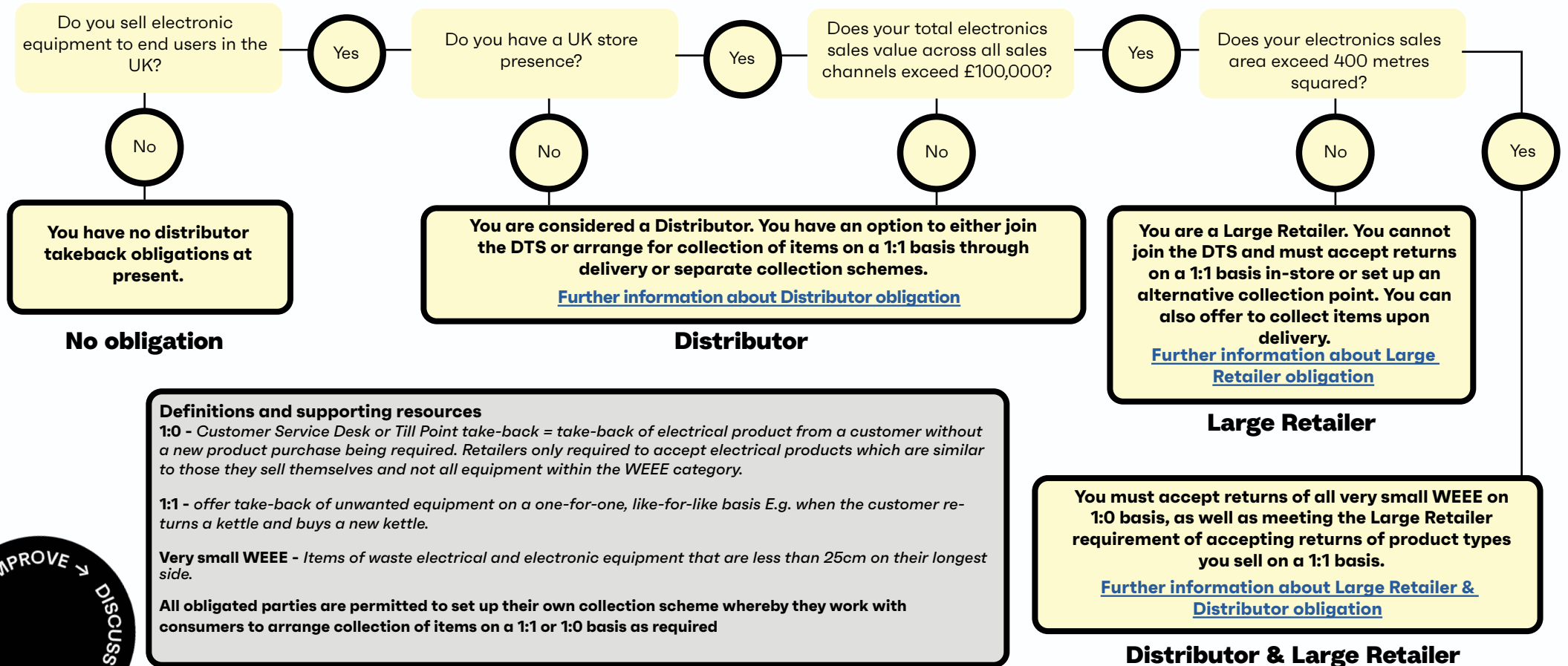


WEEE Distributor Obligation

If your business sells EEE items directly to household end users you will have an obligation as a WEEE distributor. A distributor must offer in-store take back or join the distributor take back scheme.

Definitions and supporting resources

1:0 - Customer Service Desk or Till Point take-back = take-back of electrical product from a customer without a new product purchase being required. Retailers only required to accept electrical products which are similar to those they sell themselves and not all equipment within the WEEE category.

1:1 - offer take-back of unwanted equipment on a one-for-one, like-for-like basis E.g. when the customer returns a kettle and buys a new kettle.

Very small WEEE - Items of waste electrical and electronic equipment that are less than 25cm on their longest side.

All obligated parties are permitted to set up their own collection scheme whereby they work with consumers to arrange collection of items on a 1:1 or 1:0 basis as required



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
